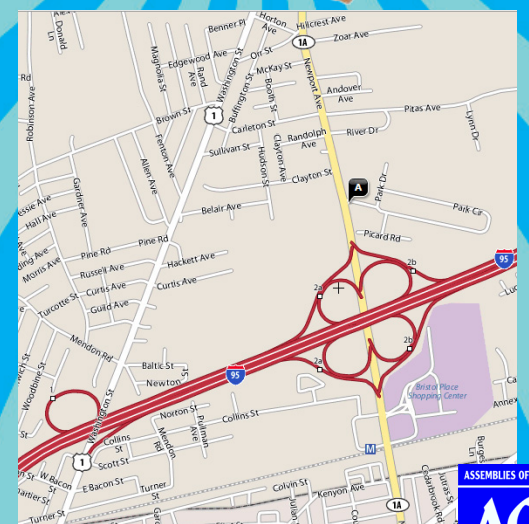
**Note: It would be of great benefit to the individual and to the church body if deacons, board members, elders, and Sunday School teachers as a minimum took the level one course curriculum.**

## THE COURSE

Providence Metro School of the Bible provides the Bible and practical ministry courses needed to fulfill the educational requirements for ministry credentials with the Assemblies of God.

## HOW IT WORKS

Students can enroll at any time. After enrolling, you begin with the next scheduled courses. Each class requires about ten hours of study in addition to the class work. The class work per course is covered one hour each Friday or Saturday and includes seven (7) hours of classroom work and a final exam. Normally each student would take two courses per eight week session.
